RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING FIRST RESPONDERS AND FRONTLINE WORKERS DURING COVID-19

WHEREAS on March 20, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo signed the New York State on PAUSE executive order, closing 100% of non-essential businesses statewide amidst a public health emergency, and

WHEREAS among those who continued their dedicated service to the City of Geneva in the midst of a national crisis were the city's first responders and frontline workers to include the fire department, police department, department of public works, healthcare workers, EMT's, grocery, maintenance, production workers, agricultural workers, and truck drivers. Many of these people were separated from their families and loved ones for long periods of time while providing much needed assistance to our community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Geneva City Council hereby wishes to thank our first responders and frontline workers, who worked during the COVID-19 pandemic, for their dedication and sacrifices made during these unprecedented times.
