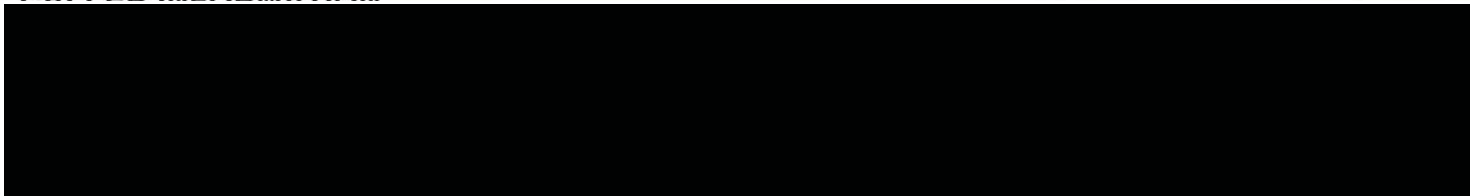

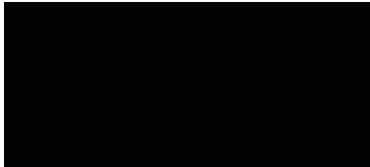

on the [redacted] I was having a heated conversation with my brother on the phone in which I [redacted] inadvertently became loud and excited while walking out the [redacted] when I reached outside I was no longer talking to my brother on the phone I was talking to my step father [redacted] when the officer pulled up and asked me for my ID. I handed him my NYS benefit card. so later on during this occurrence I was never give my ID's back and I notice that my NJ driver's license was missing as well. My father was on the phone all during this incident he heard what happen and while I was in the police car he heard what was going on and had asked me why are they giving me a ticket. He also heard while they were asking me question and laudness from the officers. He was very concerned about me (my father [redacted] that I didnt notice until I was release that he left three voice mails. I wouldn't have filed this complaint asking for my ID's, spoke to Desk sat at the percent and officer S. Barrett. This is total unprofessional and I suffer mental illness and my symtpons dont allow me to easily calm down like others and I recieve treatment from Ontario county mental Health. The officers were inforned of my conditions and still refused to acknowledge that I have mental problems and I should have been treated with better care. As a note I have treatment diagnoses and symtpons from Ontario County mental health. And this officer and as well as the other officer were unnessecarilly ruff with me because I was very loud and hyperactive (I was born with hyperactiveness and Ontario county mental health knows this, this is a form of discrimination, and prejudice treatment because of how I look and act.
